
STEP 1: REFER TO THE APPOINTMENT REMINDER EMAIL

Start in the right browser on your computer. Google Chrome or Firefox works best for this telemedicine appointment.

Open the appointment email reminder from iHeal Naples and click the embedded telemedicine link.


STEP 2: JOIN MEETING

Two minutes before your appointment starts, click **join meeting**. Your computer will prompt you to allow the system to access your microphone and camera.

STEP 3: RELAX

If you see this screen, you're in the right place. Now, you just wait for Dr. Everett to appear.

GENERAL RULES...

- You can see, but you can't hear. Test to see that your computer volume is loud enough for you to hear by playing music or a video. Next, check your browser's address bar for a speaker icon. Ensure that you browser allows the audio. If you are still unable to connect to audio on your computer, please call (855) 498-7444 and enter your meeting code (the nine digit code at the end of the telemedicine consultation URL in your address bar).
- It takes two. If you can see yourself but not Dr. Everett, make sure you accessed the link from the appointment reminder email. If you rescheduled your appointment at any point before the meeting, make sure that you are using the most recent appointment reminder email.
